The Cottage also offers internships to undergraduate and graduate-level students and serves as a training center for nursing and medical students and professionals across the country seeking sub-specialty training in forensics. 


The sponsorship award winner is the couple with the total number of pre-sold votes, ads, and sponsorships before tonight's event.

The Marching Wildcats have won more than 14 Grand Championships in the last 10 years. Dr. Kiene was named "Teacher of the Year" for RHHS and the Bryan County School (BCS) System for the 2010-2011 school year, "Star Teacher" for RHHS and the BCS System in 2015, and he received the National Band Association Citation of Excellence in 2013 during the band's performance as a Georgia Band of Distinction at Georgia State University. He was also named as a quarter-finalist in the Grammy Foundation's 2015 Music Educator Grammy Award Program. Dr. Kiene has served as adjudicator for multiple concert and marching events, as a clinician for the Savannah Chatham School District and the Armstrong Chapter of the college National Association for Music Education, and as a student teacher supervisor for both Armstrong and Georgia Southern Universities.
